We know there's no one type of student at the University of Melbourne and together with your support we'll continue to advocate for representation, quality education and a vibrant campus for all students.

## FOR YOUR EDUCATION

We believe students should be able to rely on their Union to keep them informed of changes that will effect their education & be a strong, strident voice in defence of its quality. We believe in a free and equitable education, not more debt. We will:

- Fight government attacks on higher education including deregulation, funding cuts & lower HECS repayment threshold
- We will always oppose any increases to student debt
- Secure safe 24 hour study spaces and longer library hours
- Oppose any proposal to remove student control of timetables
- · Reduce the scope for lecturers to "opt-out" of lecture recording
- Support better online resources, including the LMS, without sacrificing face-to-face learning or contact with academics
- Address the failures of the Special Consideration process and make it faster, simpler and easier to understand
- Demand increased staffing and resources for Stop 1 and 13MELB for better advice and shorter wait-times
- . Work with the staff union (NTEU) to defend learning conditions
- Advocate for anonymous marking to prevent unconscious bias
- · Ensure students receive more extensive feedback on assessment

### FOR A SAFE CAMPUS

For too long, safety on campus has not been treated seriously by universities, that's why we're putting it at the centre of our campaign. We will hold the University to account on its rhetoric and make sure their words are finally backed up by real action:

- Publish clear, up to date information on how to report assault on and off campus and available support services
- Launching a Union wide campaign to hold the University to account on improving reporting procedures and cultural attitudes towards assault, harassment & discrimination
- · Better training for staff in welfare and support
- Organise consent and welfare workshops before and during orientation with a focus on reaching colleges
- Running workshops on healthy relationships and safe sex
- Ensuring the Uni security app is available for all phones

## FOR ALL STUDENTS

Our candidates come from all walks of life and all parts of our wonderfully diverse University. What brings us together is our commitment and dedication to a left-wing and inclusive Union that represents all students. Our plans include:

- Establishing a university scholarship for refugee students
- Providing more support and advice to students on their workplace rights, especially for international students
- Introducing halal & kosher options at Tuesday BBQs
- · Continue to support the Fossil Free MU Campaign
- Fully fund & resource the People of Colour Dept. in its first year
- Promoting support services and reducing stigma around mental health issues with a Mental Health Week
- Continue the weekly free breakfast and Stress Less Week
- Expanding O-Week into a multi-week festival for new and returning students with engaging and diverse events
- Ensuring students from marginalised groups are included and consulted in the Student Representative Network
- · Supporting Women in STEM with networking & industry events
- Support students who are parents & improve parent rooms

- Consolidate UMSU's existing volunteering programs

- A more representative Union: Established the People of Colour & Disabilities Departments, increased representation of Women
- Led the highly successful campaign on campus against the Liberal Government's plans for deregulation and \$100k degrees
- Established the UMSU Food Bank & expanded it to the VCA
- Lowered the GPA/WAM for exchange from 75% to 65%
- Secured the mandatory lecture recording policy




